Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:** *Staff will be available before school for 30 minutes and after school for 30 minutes and during their plan period. Please be courteous by calling ahead to ensure availability of teacher.*
- **Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:** *All parents are encouraged to volunteer and observe classes at any time. A variety of parent engagement activities are provided. Please call 947-6273 to make arrangements.*

ASTEC Parents will support our children's learning in the following ways by:

- Monitoring and supporting good student attendance and prompt arrival at school.
- Making sure homework is completed.
- Monitoring amount of television my child watches and overseeing my student's technology usage.
- Volunteering in my child's classroom if needed.
- Participating, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my children's education.
- Promoting positive use of my child's extracurricular time.
- Staying informed about my child's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school/district and responding promptly if needed.
- Serving, to the extent possible, on policy advisory groups, such as being the Title I parent representative on the school's School Improvement Team or Safe Schools Committee.
